

# Young Guns Container Crew focuses on youth

While most companies put an emphasis on age and experience, Brisbane-based Young Guns Container Crew goes against the norm.

Since it started in 2004, the family-owned business has employed more than 400 young people with an average age of 24.

“That’s our focus for a business,” said managing director Scott Young, who started the company with his brother Trent and three employees.

“We have created a stepping stone for these young guys into the workforce. We are passionate about giving them the support and confidence they need to find their feet both in society and professionally.”

These days Young Guns has offices in Brisbane, Sydney, Perth and Melbourne and the team loads and unloads an average of 140,000 shipping containers a year.

The Young brothers want to create careers for their staff in the logistics industry.

“There is an ageing population issue within the supply chain industry and here at Young Guns we believe we can usher in the next generation,” Mr Young said.
